Covid Variant Precautions at Union UMC, Irmo. From the Trustee Committee-

With the rapid surge in Covid cases due to the Delta variant, and the break-through cases where persons vaccinated have become infected, we are reinstating some basic precautions for our worship services. We encourage, but do not mandate, that everyone wear a mask in worship and small group settings.

The side sections of the sanctuary will be marked for every-other pew sitting for those who prefer more distancing. We will discontinue using the attendance pads and return to registering our attendance with the tear-off forms on the bulletins. We also are postponing passing the collection plates and ask you to continue to give using the collection baskets in the narthex, or to give on-line.

Because of our concern for our children and others who may be vulnerable, we feel these precautions are needed. We also realize that over the past several months Union has been fortunate (blessed) to be able to continue with services and ministries without creating any spreader events. We would rather take precautions now than to face worse conditions. Please help us care for one another. Also, let us continue to pray for those who have been infected, for those in the medical professions who are battling this infection, and for the healing of our land.

Thanks to this congregation's faithfulness, Union has purchased two new StarTrans buses to replace our 2005 models. As good stewards of the church's resources, we want to make sure these new buses are properly operated and maintained. To ensure our members know how to safely drive the buses, training sessions for UUMC drivers have been planned.




