

What Do You See?

This is apple season and it reminded me of a story I heard years ago. A kindergarten teacher asked her class, "What is the color of apples?" Most of the children answered red. A couple of children said green. But one student raised her hand and said white. The teacher tried to explain that apples could be red or green or even golden. But never white. But the student was insistent, and finally said, "Look inside."

Children can always surprise us, and teach us, with their way of seeing things. In this case the child's view reminds us to examine the way we look – maybe not so much at apples, but at one another perhaps. The exterior view tells us of our differences. But on the inside we see that except for the presence of Christ, we are all sinners with nothing to commend us. The famous evangelist Dwight Moody was reported to pass by a wino lying in

the street one day and to comment, "There, but for the grace of God, lies Dwight Moody."

The Bible teaches us that God looks upon our hearts. In kindergarten terms we'd say, "Jesus always looks inside." We humans can't seem to see beyond our outward appearances. But through the eyes of Christ, we can look beyond our differences to the way we are connected in his love. So as you enjoy the autumn apples, look inside, and remember to be careful how you look at those around you.

If we can get past Halloween, and avoid being too quickly absorbed with Christmas, November offers us a time of reflection and gratitude. We begin with our All Saint's Observance on November 5th. Pausing to give thanks for those who have gone on to the Church Triumphant makes me think of all those who have gone ahead and whose lives have blessed us.

November 5th is also the end of Daylight Savings Time (so "fall back" everyone)! And, in our Growing and Giving Campaign for our Building Fund and Ministry Fund for 2024, we celebrate the Impact of our Ministry. If you keep up with what's going on at Union, you know we won't have time to acknowledge the full scale of our impact, but we'll have reminders of the difference for good that God allows us to make in people's lives.

Our Commitment Sunday is on November 19th. Please make a special effort to be present and if you can't be here, to get your commitment card in. We need to finish strong in our giving this year, and in our preparations for next year. Continue to pray, "Lord, what do you want to do through me?"

The Martha Circle started this school year packing 110 bags to send home with children every week. The purpose of these bags is to fill the bellies of kids who may not be getting proper nutrition at home. Our hope is that they take these bags home over the weekend and return to school on Monday, fed and ready to learn. This is is our highest number yet.

We split up into 3 teams and each team was given \$200 to buy supplies and see who could pack the most complete Snack Packs with their budget. Roughly 90 bags were packed between the teams, which is still not enough to feed the 110 kids this ministry feeds weekly.

Be in prayer for our confirmands and their leaders as they go on their Confirmation Retreat, October 27-29.


They will be headed to Epworth by the Sea for a great weekend of learning about God, the Methodist doctrine, and having some fun too!




