“Show Me The Money Love”

February, the month of love is here, so let's “Show the Love!” I'm not talking about romantic love. {That I leave you to handle on your own.} Rather, it's a good time to be intentional about showing the love of Christ.

The Apostle Paul wrote: “Walk in love, as Christ loved us, and gave himself for us.” Eph 5:2

That brief scripture says two things to me. First, walking in love is different than just choosing love in specific instances. Walking in love means making it a way of life. Secondly, to love as Christ loved, giving himself for us, means that loving will be sacrificial. To love as Christ loves means I am willing to give up something of myself - my time, my rights, my comfort, my money, my privilege, my space, my attention, and so on.

The experience of receiving such sacrificial gifts from someone can be inspiring and transformational. Again the Apostle Paul: “Let each of you look not to your own interests but to the interests of others. Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus.” (Phil 2)

I invite you to join me in praying about how we each can grow by intentionally showing the love of Christ. Each day ask God, “How can I best show the love of Christ today?” And then pay attention, the answer may be closer than you expect!

I also invite you to being intentional about showing Christ's love at church. Yep, people can fall into a me-first attitude even at church. Do you have a preferred “space” in the pew, or the parking lot that you aren't happy about giving up? Do you go “out of your way” for others, or have you fallen into the trap of “each to his/her own?”

Remember, there are little things, important things, you can do to keep the focus on showing self-giving love at church. By the way, I've gotten reports from recent guests that they have been warmly welcomed at Union. That's great, and so important, and here's five easy ways to continue to show the love:

1. Wear your name tag to church.
2. Sign the guest register in the pew, which encourages our guests to sign in.
3. Greet others with your smile, and make room for folks.
4. Introduce yourself to those you don't know, and invite them to a class with you.
5. Make your welcome more than a greeting, begin a friendship.

What we experience when we focus on loving others is that our own world expands. The spirit of Christ continues to open and to fill our own hearts. I guess that's one reason the scriptures also say: Sisters and brothers, let us love not in word or speech, but in our deeds and in truth. 1 John 3:18.

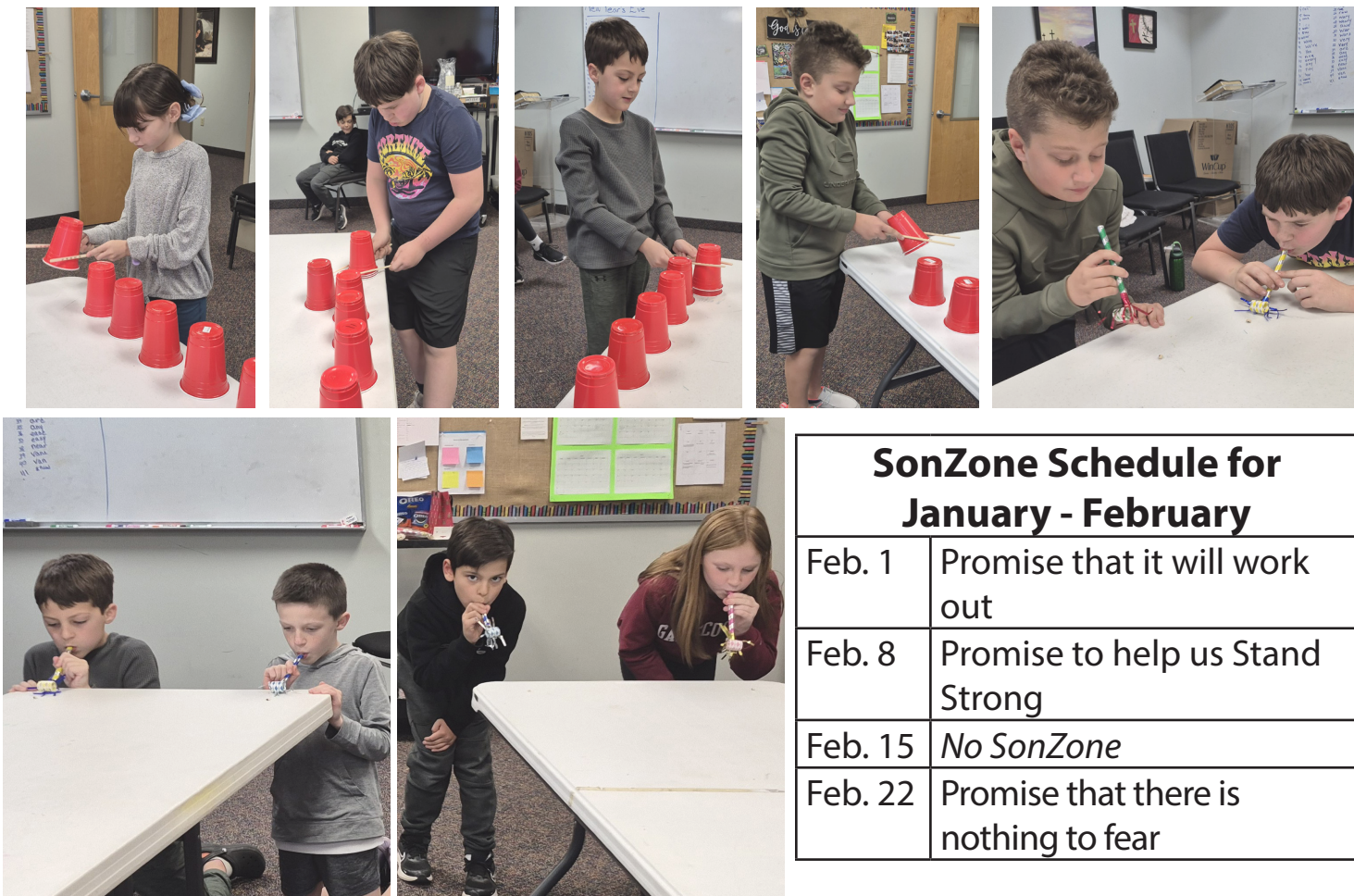

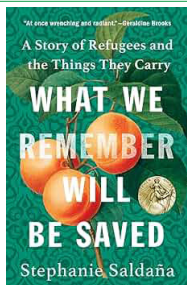


Summer 2026 Mission Trip

Wilson Circle Book Club

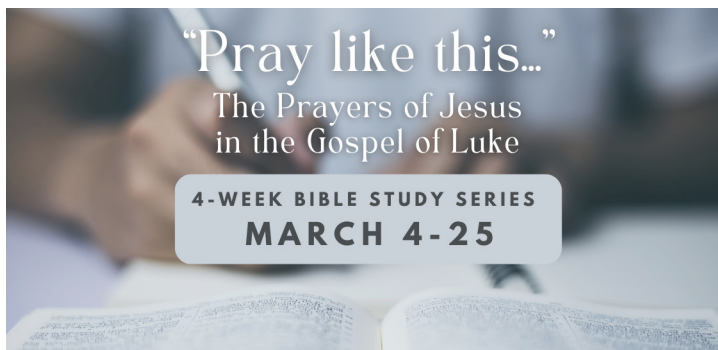
The next meeting of the Wilson Circle Book Club is on Tuesday, **February 10, 2026** at 1:30pm in the Fellowship Hall. We will be discussing the book, *What We Remember Will Be Saved: A Story of Refugees and the Things They Carry* by Stephanie Saldaña.

Saldaña, a journalist and scholar who lived in Syria before the war, journeys across nine countries to meet refugees and learn what they took with them when they escaped. What she discovered was little things matter a great deal. Saldaña introduces us to “a woman who saved her city in a dress, a musician who saved his stories in songs, and a couple who rebuilt their destroyed pharmacy even as the city around them fell apart.” She shows the reader a religiously diverse corner of the Middle East on the edge of unraveling and the people keeping it alive with their stories.

There are 3 copies of the book in the UWF collection in the Church Library, one copy in the Lexington Public Library, and a copy in Hoopla through the Richland Public Library. You do not need to be a member of the Wilson Circle to participate in the Book Club. All are welcome to join us.
