- God's Promise of Restoration: Isaiah 61:7 teaches us that God will replace shame and confusion with double blessings. No matter the pain or loss we've experienced, God's restoration is abundant and complete.
- Forgiveness as a Pathway to Blessings: Forgiveness is the key to unlocking God's
 promises of restoration. When we release our hurt and trust God with the situation, we
 make space for Him to heal us and bless us with more than what was lost.
- Writing the Vision: Habakkuk 2:2-3 urges us to write the vision and make it plain. By writing down our desires for restoration, we align ourselves with God's promises. This act of faith helps clarify our expectations and brings us closer to seeing His blessings fulfilled in our lives.

Homework Prompt: "It is a year from now. You are on the other side of forgiveness, living in the freedom and peace that it has brought you. Write a letter of gratitude to God, describing how these blessings have impacted your life and how forgiveness has led to your freedom."

Job 22:28 says, "Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and the light shall shine upon thy ways." Therefore, it is important that in addition to writing our vision, we also decree or affirm it. Say the following affirmation or create one of your own.
