GET RELAXED ABOUT TAX

January brings with it the deadline for submitting Self Assessment tax returns and paying any taxes owed. If you haven't submitted your 2019-20 tax return yet here are a few things to account that were deferred from July

- The Self-employed can claim expenses for working from home. Claim a proportion of your costs for items such as heating, Council Tax and mortgage interest or rent.
- Don't forget! If your tax bill for the year is over £1,000 and you pay less than 80% of your taxes through Pay As You Earn then you'll also need to pay an advance 'payment on account' on 31 January towards next year's tax bill.
- Taxpayers with a tax bill under £30,000 can use HMRC's Time to

March 2021 - Chancellor to announce the Government's new budget (date yet to be confirmed at the time of

31 March 2021 - VAT payment deadline for all payments not paid due to Coronavirus. Opt into the new VAT deferral payment plan, which launches in early 2021 and payments can be spread out to March 2022.


