Guyer Choir Craft Show: Vendor Rules

- Vendor check-in begins at 6:30 AM. Please **DO NOT** enter the building before that time as we are busy with last-minute preparations. You may park briefly in front of the school, or in the back loading zone (nearest the courtyard) while you check in. You will have 2 ½ hours for setup. The show starts at 9:00 AM and ends at 4:00 PM. We are unable to allow Friday night set-up because the school is in use by other groups which does not allow us to secure your property.
- When you arrive, **please go directly to your booth for set up.** A choir booster representative will be coming to your booth to check you in and see if you have everything that you need.
- One week prior to the Craft Show you will receive an email letting you know the closest place to unload your vehicle. Student volunteers may be available to help. Please be mindful that we have more vendors than students and cannot guarantee one will be available for you. The school does not have enough flat-bed dollies for your use. Please be prepared to move your own merchandise. After you have unloaded, please park in the F lot on the South side of the building or the B lot on the North side of the building to allow patrons to shop at your booths. Please move your car before you set up your booth.
- If you rented a table, it will be at your booth when you arrive. If you paid for electricity, your booth will be located near an outlet. Please bring any necessary extension cords with you.
- Please maintain your booth so that it looks pleasant throughout the show. Please keep your booth in
 its designated area. All items displayed must be appropriate for students (nothing sexually explicit or
 crude). All booths must be manned by an adult. Booth payment is due before you may set up your
 booth. Returned check fee is \$35.
- Profanity is not allowed verbal or written. No lit candles or open flames. Smoking is not allowed. Nails in our walls are strictly prohibited as is defacing our school's property in any way.
- Lunch will not be provided. However, feel free to come by our concession stand. There are also several food options located close to Guyer High School to run and pick up food or order for delivery.
- It is each vendor's responsibility to ensure that they are in complete compliance with the law regarding food permits and taxes. If you have food items, you may need a permit. Please contact the City of Denton's Consumer Health Department at 940-349-8346. The city health inspector visits our show. A permit is \$20 and you must apply in advance. If you are shut down for noncompliance, there is no refund. Denton's sales tax is 8.25%. If you have any questions or need a sales tax permit, please visit www.window.state.tx.us/taxes/. Refunds will not be given if you are shut down by a government official.
- Early bird registration allows returning vendors the opportunity to secure the same spot from year to year. Early bird registration and payment will be accepted starting at 10:00 AM on the day of the show. Early Bird registration will end on December 31, 2022.
- Booth teardown begins at 4:01 PM. Any vendor found breaking down prior to that will be fined \$25.
- Publicity: We advertise our Craft Show on Facebook, on a few online festival/show listing sites, in local papers, via flyers and yard signs at local schools. We ask that our vendors do what they can to promote our show to their customer base to come and support your small business. This helps bring more traffic into our doors and is good for everyone!
- We try to think of everything possible to help make our show successful for our vendors and for our customers. However, we know that we will miss a few things along the way. Therefore, we reserve the right to add or change our rules. We have everyone's best interest at heart!
