How does WHCT function?



- As a homeschooling family, you are in charge of your students' education. WHCT is not an umbrella school but rather a partnership with families.
- WHCT meets at Gateway Community Church in Franklin, Tn on Tuesdays and Thursdays from August-May with some breaks scheduled in between.
- Families are expected to schedule around the WHCT calendar and adhere to the WHCT Handbook which includes policies for academics and dress code.



- In the Spring before a given school year, WHCT families register for classes taught by tutors.
- Payments are made via checks ahead of time and dispersed to the tutors each quarter during the school year.
- Beyond the drop/add period designated by WHCT, classes are non-refundable.
- Classes at WHCT are a la carte, so you have the freedom to decide (so long as students meet pre-requisites if any) which classes your students will take. Students must sign up (& pay) for a study hall whenever they are on campus but not in a class.



- Parental involvement is key, and we want parents to pray for WHCT students, tutors, and staff.
- Though parents do not stay while their students are in their WHCT classes, WHCT needs the support of parents to keep everything running smoothly. There will be many opportunities for parents to volunteer throughout the school year.
- Besides classes and study halls, WHCT offers student activities like dances and game nights to help positively build the student community, and we need parents to help plan and execute these events.
