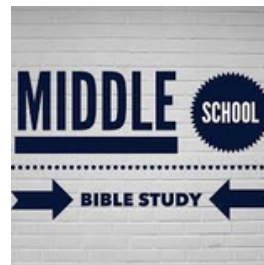
Middle School Bible

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Prerequisites:

- This class is open to all Middle School students.



Course Description

Students will get their hands on actual Bibles, as they learn the books it contains, and the groupings of those books.

First semester, they will see why God made us and the world, and be introduced to our common history and purpose. They'll examine how God created the world, how the first family was established, and how sin entered the world. They'll learn about worship's beginnings in the era of Noah and about the adventure of faith begin with Abraham and many other biblical figures: Joseph, Moses, Samuel, David, Josiah, Daniel, and Esther.

Second semester they will discover New Testament heroes, and find their place in God's story.

Homework is very simple, and encourages students to weekly apply the truths they are learning to their lives.

Books & Supplies

- Bible containing both Old and New Testament
(I recommend a Student Bible or version they are able to read with ease, and bring to tutorial.)
- 1/2" - 1" binder

Commitment

- This course is offered on Tuesdays.
- There will be a memory verse quiz most weeks.
- Quarter and semester tests will be given in class.

A typical class will look like...

Class time is a mixture of a weekly overview/aims of the lesson, the primary Bible verse, fun starters to help engage students in the topic, the Bible story itself (presented in various ways), and application opportunities to help students see how God's Word connects with their world.
