Course Description

The WHCT Yearbook class primarily exists with the intention of producing the yearly WHCT yearbook.

Each student in the class will be assigned individual projects as well as group projects. These projects will teach various types of skill sets which include graphic design elements, basic writing, grammar editing, organization skills, planning, and communication.

The class will make decisions on book cover design, theme, font, colors, page set-up, and information that will be included in the book.

Each student will be required to attend at least one event throughout the school year to gain information about the theme, attendance, and pictures of the event, similar to how a reporter would collect information for a news source.

Students will not only be actively creating a published book, but they will also learn leadership skills, group project cooperation, resume building, goal setting, and email etiquette.

- Each student will need a laptop in class.

Commitment

- This course meets once a week for half of the WHCT academic year.
- It is worth .5 credit for high school students, but is open to all students.
- 1-2 hour per week of assigned homework
