


Please take note that our academic classes are college preparatory level, so please notice the difference as to which classes are Middle School options and with classes are High School options when you are planning your student's schedule.







*We do NOT offer Middle School level Spanish or French. French I will not be offered in the 2024-25 school year. Spanish and French can be taken any two years of high school, but it is recommended that students take them early to finish their 2 year Foreign Language requirement. Currently, we do not offer higher than level 1 in ASL. Further language instruction must be taken outside of WHCT.
