



Prerequisites:

- This class is open to 8th-12th grade students



Course Description:

This course is an introduction to floral design where students get to work hands-on creating table arrangements, handheld & bridal bouquets, corsages, boutonnieres, and special occasion florals. Classes will also include identification, processing florals and greenery, color theory, and product sourcing. Students will take home a minimum of 8 floral designs throughout the semester.

Note: We plan to offer floral orders for select special occasions, such as Valentines day, theater productions, and spring formal. Students will learn how to price, source supplies, and promote their products. The proceeds will help with the cost of floral supplies for the semester.



Commitment:

- This class meets once a week. This is a SPRING ONLY class
- Homework is minimal, occasionally including sourcing florals and bringing them to class
- Grade is based on participation



A typical class will look like...

Classes will consist of hand-on design a minimum of every other week. Classes will start with proper tool care, floral care and processing, and spend the remainder of the class creating our designs. On the alternative weeks, we will work on design and technical principals.



Books and Supplies*

Required Supplies:

- Floral shears
- 1 roll green floral tape
- 1 roll floral wire
- 1 block floral foam

Optional supplies:

- Light gloves
- Apron
- Final project supplies
