



Personal Finance

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Prerequisites:

- This course open to 10th-12th grade high school students.



Course Description:

Set your students up to win with the Foundations in Personal Finance curriculum. Students will learn how to use money and business principles for real-world applications.

The homework will include videos, additional online resources, questions, quizzes, and an end-of-semester presentation on a Personal Finance topic of their choice.



Commitment:

- This course meets once a week.
- It is a .5 credit course that meets for half of the academic year.
- The chapter work for each week's assignment will include watching online videos, completing questions, and taking weekly 5- to 8-question quizzes, which are due by Monday evenings.
- In lieu of a final, the students will prepare an end-of-semester presentation. The presentation is 3 minutes in length, on an economic topic of their choice.
- The homework will be approximately 2 hours per week.

We will cover various Personal Finance topics each week and have class discussions on the applicable topics. We will also work in teams during class time to accomplish the tasks related to the applicable topics.
