



# High School Theater

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## Prerequisites:

## Course Description:

High School Theater is a performance based class that performs a play in the fall semester and a musical in the spring semester.

*(Tech week is April 25-30<sup>th</sup>)*



## Commitment:

- This course meets for 1 hour and 30 minutes after regular tutorial hours. Siblings not in HS theater must be picked up at 3pm and cannot stay during this class.
- Tech week, which is the week of the show (Sunday through Saturday) is mandatory for every performer.
- Parts are assigned through auditions in class



## A typical class will look like...

The first few weeks of the year are spent doing theater games, characterization, projection. Auditions for each show are held in class. Each semester is spent blocking and rehearsing the show we plan to perform. Every student enrolled in the class will have a part in both shows.



## Books and Supplies

Scripts provided via lab fee

Costumes are the student's responsibility but I also have many things that I can supply. A costume idea will be sent home several weeks before each show and will be required to be provided 3 weeks before the show date.

Specific group costumes are provided by the theater lab fund but each individual is responsible for basic items such as shoes, leggings, t-shirt, etc...
