- This course is open to students grades 6-8.



Course Description:

- This class explores the people, places, events, and ideas that have shaped Tennessee into the state it is today.
- Students will make maps, try time period foods, research and present on one of TN's State Parks, and attend some (optional) local field trips, to enhance their study of our state.
- This course will encourage and support reading comprehension, attention to detail, presentation skills, time management, creativity, and more.



Commitment:

- This course meets once a week.
- Weekly homework assignments should take 1-2 hours to complete, with projects requiring additional time.




A typical class will look like...
