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## Prerequisites:

- This class is open to all middle school students.



## Course Description:

Since the Garden of Eden, God has been revealing the kind of loving and personal God He is. This course covers the beginning of time, through Jesus' life on earth, c.A.D. 30, from a Christian worldview.

## A typical class will look like...


Class time includes a review of the material from the week's reading (homework), building a notebook sized timeline, as well as various activities and exercises to help bring the material to life.
