Course Description:

We will take a look at American history from the mid-1800s through a distinctly Christian lens, with units on the Civil War and Reconstruction, the Gilded Age, World Wars I & II, The Great Depression, the Cold War and more!

We will also incorporate fun activities while learning about the food eaten during each time period, presidents, states, and capitals, and even having a class mock election! There will be 2 projects incorporated into our learning as well as the final exam covering the memorization of the states and capitals.
