

# STEPS TO REGISTRATION

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1. Intent to Return Form or New Student Application
2. Placement Test (if needed)
3. Registration Fee Paid & Registration Contract Signed
4. Course Selection [Returns **March 23<sup>rd</sup>** / New Families **April 6<sup>th</sup>**]
5. WHCT Fees & Tuition submitted on **PAYMENT DAY: April 16<sup>th</sup>**
6. Last Chance to Drop a class with refund, May 14<sup>th</sup>

# COURSE & FEE PLANNER

- Operation Fees per Course \$85 year / \$45 for semester
- Lab Fees vary by course
- Graduation fee for seniors planning to participate in graduation ceremony
- All lines above are totaled and written as 1 check to WHCT on April 16<sup>th</sup>
- Tuition Payments are divided into 4 quarterly payments (Aug, Oct, Jan, Mar)
- Tuition Checks are written directly to the Tutors
- All checks are prewritten, post-dated and submitted to tutorial on April 16<sup>th</sup>
- ORDER MORE CHECKS NOW
- Registration Contract - read over what you sign on registration day

### Parent Honor Code 2026-2027

- I will read through the Student Honor code with my student(s) and agree to the policies set forth in the WHCT Family Handbook.
- It is necessary for the operation of this type of program that both tutors and parents make a commitment for the entire academic year. Therefore, all tuition and fees are now non-refundable.
- It is my responsibility to assess my student's ability to work within the standards of the program, particularly if my child has special needs or a learning disability.
- I will check assignments and will have materials needed for my student's classes. I will provide the needed amount of accountability for my student at home. I understand that WHCT works best with the partnership of the parents.
- If a problem arises between my student and a tutor, I will contact the tutor first. If the matter cannot be resolved with the tutor, I will reach out to the director.
- I will administer and proctor any take home tests and will return tests to tutorial in a sealed envelope with my signature on the outside.
- I will communicate with tutors, board members and the director in the least obtrusive way. I will use written communication whenever possible. I understand that right before class is not the best time to catch a tutor.
