



FAQ

Q: WHAT GRADE LEVELS DO YOU SERVE?

A: *West Harpeth Christian Tutorial (aka WHCT) serves homeschooled students in grades 6-12. Students must have been homeschooled for at least one year prior to beginning at WHCT.*

Q: ARE YOU AN UMBRELLA SCHOOL?

A: *No, WHCT is NOT an umbrella school. We are simply a tutorial offering classes that parents might want to outsource to more knowledgeable tutors. All prospective and current students must be registered with an umbrella school or as independent homeschoolers with the state of Tennessee. You can find details on all of the requirements in Tennessee on the HSLDA website.*

Q: WHAT CLASSES DO YOU OFFER?

A: We offer a variety of classes from core academics to electives. All of our core academics to electives. All of our core academic classes are considered college-prep-level classes. Our current classes and schedule can be viewed on the "About us" tab on our website.

Q: WHAT WILL IT COST ME TO ENROLL MY STUDENT IN WHCT?

*A: Registration Fees:
Returning Student- \$270
(family cap of \$810)*

*New Student- \$300
(family cap of \$900)*

*Operation Fees:
\$85 per course per year,
\$45 for a one-semester course*

Lab Fees: These are paid to WHCT each year for courses requiring a lab fee and vary per course.

Tuition: These fees are paid directly to tutors via personal checks submitted during Spring registration. These are distributed to tutors each quarter by WHCT.

*Two day per week class-
\$600/year- \$150 per quarter*

*One day per week class-
\$400/year- \$100 per quarter*

*One semester, one day per week class-
\$200/year= \$100 per quarter*

*Social Hall Fee: (also paid directly to study hall monitors)
\$60 per hour, plus one yearly operational fee per student.*

Q: DO YOU REPORT GRADES?

A: Our tutors report earned grades for each class to the parents. It is then the PARENT(S)' RESPONSIBILITY to report those grades to your chosen umbrella school or to the county where your student is registered.

Q: DO YOU ACCEPT STUDENTS HALF-WAY THROUGH THE ACADEMIC YEAR?

A:WHCT ONLY accepts new students and returning students during spring registration that happens before the new Academic year begins. Students may not sign up for WHCT half way through the academic year. For families withdrawing their student from public or private school, please note that it is our policy that families homeschool for a full year before they can attend WHCT.

Q: WHEN CAN NEW FAMILIES APPLY TO WHCT?

A:New family applications will be available January 1st each year. When applying in January, families are applying to the next Academic year beginning in August, not the current Academic year.

More details can be found under the enrollment tab on our website. We encourage all families to sign up for a tour in the fall BEFORE application season, so they can become familiar with how WHCT functions. Tours will be announced at the end of august, so keep an eye out on the website to sign up. We will go over this during tours, but we encourage families who truly want to apply to begin the process laid out in the Enrollment tab well before Christmas.
