It was a wonderful opportunity give them the gospel while also providing the moms with basic necessities. We are so thankful for the door of ministry opportunity that the Lord has opened,

We look forward to a special Christmas outreach of taking treats to approximately 60 staff, delivering over 2000 diapers, and caroling.
