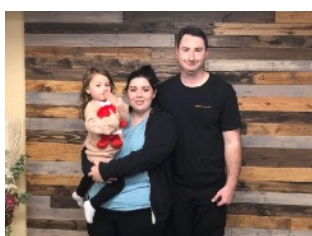




Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it. 1Thessalonians 5:24

Greetings! A heartfelt thanks goes out to each of you who faithfully pray for and support us and the ministry here. We are grateful for each of you and pray for you as you stay faithful to God. It has been a busy last three months and I am excited for this report to go out. We have celebrated Easter, held our annual Missions Conference (Took on 4 new missionary families!), and celebrated mothers and fathers. We are also both excited and blessed to see three precious souls (2 Military Men, 1 Lady) saved and baptized. The newly saved couple is being discipled and they have both jumped headfirst into serving God and endeavoring to obey His commandments in their daily walk. Praise the Lord!

ATTENTION, Great News Ahead! Since our eviction from our current building, God has placed a huge opportunity before us blessing us with a building to purchase. He has also miraculously moved on the heart of the owner who has agreed to a “rent to own” contract for the next 9 months after which we will purchase the facility. All the money paid in rent will be deducted from the final price of the building. This type of contract is completely unheard of in Japan. Additionally, the purchase price is less than half the value of the property. With the current exchange rate, we will only pay approximately \$320,000 for the entire property which has a current value of over \$800,000! The new facility is much larger than what we have now affording us the opportunity for future growth and dedicated Sunday School space. We see God moving on the owner and are humbly asking for your assistance. To this end, we are kicking off a \$10 drive. Our church has already begun giving and we are asking you to consider having each of your church members do the same. We are asking that each person give \$10 toward the purchase of this new property. If each of our supporting churches, their members, and all our praying friends and families give \$10 per person the \$320,000 goal is quickly attainable. We are also asking that you spread the news to other churches and individuals that would be willing to help with this purchase. The amazing thing is that the property and building will be completely owned by YBC and there will be a church there until Christ returns. To my knowledge, this would be the first military work in Japan to own our own facility and property. God has given us this opportunity and we are excited to begin renovations. We are eternally grateful to each of you and thank you in advance for joining with us to place a permanent church in Yokosuka Japan.
