
Greetings All,

Several prayer requests this time. We are getting our Covid tests for our return on December 4, please pray for a negative test. Our return flight is leaving out of Detroit on December 6. Please pray that all of the details of the flight will go as planned, no complications. Also, please pray for our readjustment to the European life after being back for a few months. The Netherlands is getting close to a new lockdown, pray we get back before this is implemented. Pray for the church in the Netherlands, we heard last Wednesday, there are several people dealing with covid. One whole family tested positive and are at high risk because of underlying issues. We will begin searching for a new meeting place for the church when we return. Pray the Lord helps us find the perfect place for the work to increase. Please pray for each other! The opportunity to be discouraged is everywhere, but we don't need to dwell there!!
