Overcoming Trials, Persecution and Suffering 1 Peter 4:12-16

<u>Intro:</u> In the first-century church trials were common. In fact, Peter writes that it is common for "*fiery trials*" to come.





Brethren, October - December, 2022

Greetings in the wonderful and glorious name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. We pray that this finds you all enjoying the goodness of our great God and King.

Much has happened since our last report, and we rejoice to see the Lord continue to work as we labor here in the Highlands of PNG.

In October, our family had a great opportunity to go to the town of Wau(pronounced WOW). I was able to teach in the Bible School there for a week on Bible Issues and History. We were blessed to take some extra time on the way there and back in the city of Lae to have a small family vacation. The guesthouse there in Lae has a basketball court and a swimming pool which was a lot of fun, and we enjoyed seeing the variety of shops and restaurants in Lae as well. Lae is a coastal city, with lots of heat and humidity, so we were reminded of the weather we left behind in South Carolina when we came to PNG almost 2 years ago. While we enjoyed the time away, it was a blessing to finally make it home after 2 weeks on the road.

In December, we were again very busy with multiple meetings here in the highlands. I was blessed to be able to preach three different revival meetings in a row. Two of these meetings included the baptism of some new believers. It was exciting to baptize 16 new Christians here in Western Highlands (3 of these were our oldest boys, Donovan, Marshall, and Jeremiah) and 6 others in Chimbu province. It is exciting to have these meetings and see the fruit that comes from them afterwards.

These next few months will be very busy as preparations are being made for the start of the new Bible school here in town. In March, we will be kicking off our three-year Bible institute, Highlands Baptist Bible School, for the purpose of training men and women in the word of God and in work of the ministry. Please pray for us during this preparation time as there is much to organize and setup to do this work "decently and in order." (1 Cor. 14:40) We currently have quite a few folks signed up to start in March, many of whom are preachers and pastors here in the Highlands who have realized the needed for more academic and practical training to better serve in their ministries.

We also have plenty of young men and women who believe that God has a desire to use them in some capacity and want to come to Bible school to prepare for whatever it is God has in store for them. While some of these students live here in town, many of them will be walking and/or riding a bus for hours each week to come to class. Please pray that nothing will hinder these students in this decision they have made to come to Bible School in March.
