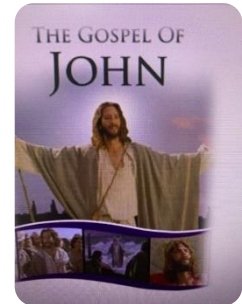
We were able to send 30 radios out to some isolated areas, via bus, airplane, canoe and finely by foot to people's homes.
