Overcoming a World in Opposition to God

1 John 5:1-5

Intro: In verses 4-5 we see the word “world” or *Kosmos*. It refers to *the present condition of human affairs in opposition to God*.

(1Jn 5:4) For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the *world*: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, *even* our faith.

(1Jn 5:5) Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

Antagonism toward God and Christianity is widespread in our World today. We need to have Faith in God no matter what the World screams or pushes on our children and family.

We are to have Faith **in** the Son of God. Faith **in** His Commandments, and Faith **in** His Plans.

I. Faith in His Son

Dear Praying Friends, March-April 22023

We would like to thank you for your continued support of our family during these trying times.

In February we preached meetings in Evansville, Indiana, and Phoenix, Arizona. It was a blessing to share with several churches what the Lord has done over the years in the Krasnoyarsk area.

In late February we went to Arizona to be with my parents as my grandmother, Dorothy Deering, had been put in a hospice facility. Just before we left for Arizona, Grandma told us she was ready to go and looking forward to being with the Lord. Grandma Deering was ninety-seven when she passed away. Until a month before she died if you had left the keys out where she could get them, she would have taken your car out for a ride.

In March we had the opportunity to visit Capital City Baptist Church in Austin, Texas, and spend some time with our friends, Pastor Adam Thompson and his wife, Kim. It was a sweet reunion as we had not seen each other in decades. It was surreal to watch our daughters, now young women in their twenties, laughing and getting to know each other as only missionary kids can seem to do.

Since we returned from Russia in November, if we are not away preaching, we have been staying busy helping out at the MIMI World Missions Headquarters. Just this past week-end we were able to assist others in the packing of a young missionary couples' shipping container and seal it up as it left for its final destination of Greenland. Please pray for the Gilberts as they begin their missionary work in a cold isolated region this month.

Please pray for Dee and me as we travel to preach in a small church in North Dakota later this month. The church needs a pastor, and there is a substantial Russian-speaking population in the area. We do not know if this is where the Lord will place us, but we eagerly await His guidance.

We also would ask you to pray with us regarding our property and house which we had to leave in Russia. There is a buyer, but the bureaucracy is making it very hard for any sale to go through. It is hard for us as we will not realize a quarter of the value of our home, but we are far more fortunate than others during these troubling times in Russia. Please pray that a sale is finalized by May. If not, the government will have the right to seize thirty percent of any sale that takes place.
