

Update Bolivia July 2023

Dear friends, prayer partners and supporters,
Time is flying by. We would like to update you on how the Chimane Conference Center is coming along.

If you want windows, you will have to cut all the lumber needed to make the frames and then attach the bug screening.



As you can see the installed windows add some flare to the building. They will have to add some

drop-down external panels to prevent rain from getting through the screen.



Some steps and a door are also in the making.
Remember you will have to cut the wood and make the doors and steps, one step at a time! NO pun intended!



Oiling the wood will help preserve it and keep the ants from wanting to build nests and eat the wood. The ends of the building need to be filled in with screen, and leaves to prevent insects from coming in.

What are the present needs to finish the center?

1. Some electrical cords, sockets, lights and hopefully two overhead fans to help move the already hot air.
2. Some chairs! We thought about keeping it native and using benches, but plastic chairs are available and can be moved so the floor can be used for other ministries. (40 chairs are needed)
3. In the very near future this building will be ready to be used. It will replace meeting in homes and sitting on the ground. I hear many are looking forward to that!

4. Future needs - A kitchen to cook in for all the visitors coming for a weekend retreat. Also, large pots are needed for cooking food.
