

Greeting from the Field,

We thank our Lord for your faithful prayers and/or support for the work here. God has blessed this month with many visitors, a special service, and a man getting assurance of his salvation. I believe in the last report I mentioned all the tracts we have been putting in the mailboxes in several cities. From the ones in Hilversum, we have had 2 visitors already, with one becoming a faithful attender on Wednesday evenings for Bible study. Two weeks ago, we had a baby dedication for 5 families that have had new babies over the last year or so. It was a full house! Many lost family members were in attendance, I was able to explain why we do not do infant baptism and give a clear gospel message. Unfortunately, we did not see anyone saved that day, but from the after reports from the families, it has opened the conversation within the families about the simplicity of salvation. We have had a man coming occasionally to church, but we hadn't seen him "in person" for a long time. I had the opportunity to meet with him last week to encourage him to come back to church and I explained the gospel. This Sunday, he finally came back (1st time in a year), and after church, he had lunch with a group of church folks. During lunch someone else walked him through the gospel and he finally said he understood what salvation really is. We are praising the Lord for his understanding, because there are several language barriers we were trying to get through for him to "get it". Neither Dutch nor English are his native tongue.

We also appreciate your prayers for the street ministry. Over the last month, we have seen an increase in interest in both attendance from the church and people in the city wanting to know more about the gospel message. Because of the increase in conversations we are having, our folks are more intent on studying to have answers to questions they are being asked. This is an answer to prayer that we have had. an increase in their spiritual growth. It is our desire not only to see souls saved, but for the church to increase in their ability to use the word of God effectively. Over the last month, I have been preaching a series on doing things God's way, not the new way. Last week was on the Biblical structure of the family. If you could pray for God to work in the hearts of our families, we would really appreciate it. It is so easy for the devil to convince people that their way is better than God's way. I'll be finishing the series this Sunday with "Biblical Church."

Since the last report, Lisa has started to disciple a woman that has come from a "New Age" back-ground, please pray for this discipleship. As we are ministering to our folks, it seems there is some kind of spiritual attack happening to most of them. Please pray with us that the Lord will help them! Please pray for all the lost that have heard the gospel or received a tract, that they become bothered by the message and put their trust in the Lord Jesus Christ. Pray that the Lord will bring us more visitors to hear the gospel and for more of the church to get involved in evangelism of some kind. Pray for our health. Pray for the spiritual growth of the man who received assurance of salvation. Pray for your church!
