Greetings to you our dear praying friends!

This letter covers our September and October activities.

With September comes spring a beautiful time of the year here. The warmer weather, the sun, showers and the beautiful flowers all lead us to worship and praise our wonderful Creator.

Saturday, September 9, we flew to Bahia Blanca, (one hour and fifteen minute flight) from us to minister for 8 days at Iglesia Bautista el Faro, (Lighthouse Baptist Church), started by Pastor David Merlo and his wife Emilce, who are in the States on furlough. What a blessing to meet the brothers and sisters of this congregation for the first time!

The day of Marty's birthday we travelled to Paysandú, Uruguay, a neighboring country, about four hours away by car. Marty spoke to 120 plus ladies at a national ladies' meeting on Saturday. I spoke at the Church there on Sunday. That work was started by missionary Roy Kuhns and his wife Karen, both now with the Lord. It sure was good to minister to the folk, some of whom we have known for many, many years. Back in Argentina we enjoyed a couple of days off.

Sunday October 1, we had a very welcomed surprise visit of Pastor James Merlo from Iglesia Bautista El Calvario of OKC (one of our supporting churches) at our Sunday night service. After the preaching, four precious souls received Christ as their personal Savior. The next morning we flew to the Fundamentalist Baptist Conference in San Rafael, Mendoza, were he spoke twice each day during the three day meeting. Many of us pastors and missionaries made a number of decisions at the altar.

On Wednesday, October 11th, we travelled by plane (two and a half hours south) to spend a week with Pastor Joe Merlo and Janice in Comodoro Rivadavia. Marty spoke to the ladies for a Mother's Day Tea. And I had the privilege to speak on Sunday to the congregation for their 26th Anniversary. What a wonderful work the Lord has done thru them. And what gracious hosts they were. We experienced wonderful hospitality and very sweet fellowship.

God is blessing the work here in Villa Tesei, at Fundamental Baptist Church. The anniversary of the church and special Mother's Day activities brought many visitors. Some of whom heard the Gospel for the first time. There is also a growing group of children coming to Sunday School. Please pray for the new believers to continue coming and growing in Christ. And for Pastor Jorge, the team, and the teachers as they minister to these children and new believers.



Sunday, October 22nd we had presidential elections here in Argentina. Two of the candidates came out very close to each other, so there will be a final election November 19th. The unstable economy and political situations is causing stress and unrest among the people.
