We are preparing for our Missions Conference at Old Paths Baptist Church, and our folks have never been more excited about this meeting. We have a wedding for one of our families in the church. We praise the Lord for their decision to make things right before God. We started a school with eight students last month, and we are thankful to invest in the young people of our church. Please pray for wisdom and provision in this matter.

We had a fantastic Missions Conference at Newcomb Baptist Church; our church got behind a Navajo Church Planter who will start a church on the western part of the reservation. Since the conference, our folks have come out to soul-winning every week. We have made some progress on the new building, but due to our schedules and workload, we try to do what we can. We are now working on the finish work (drywall tape and mud); if you would like to help and are experienced, we could use your help.

Our family has been battling some sickness as of late. We got hit with sickness in the middle of a momentum; other than the sickness, our family is in good spirits, and we are so thankful to serve our Navajo people.
