MINISTRY UPDATES


Unlike the United States, things slow down quite a bit around this time of year in our area of South Africa. Many locals travel away from Knysna for the holiday and school is on its summer break, so many of our regular ministries are paused. Instead, we focus more on community events and reaching out to our neighbors who are still in town.

We hosted the "appetizer course" for the Knysna Hope Teen Progressive Dinner in early December. We had 38 in attendance and it was wonderful to have a full house as I could put some faces to names Hudson has come to know through the teen boys' Bible study.

The four kids all participated in the Knysna Hope Christmas Nativity play and carol sing earlier this month. They each worked very hard learning their lines as the child (Nate), teenager (Zach), adult (Hudson) and angel (Amalia) as we shared the gospel through word and song.

In our continued attempts to connect with our community, this month we have been reaching out to families with young children. Just at our church, Lakeside Baptist, we have at least three other families (two with four young children each). We have had them in our home, gone to dinner or lunch with them and enjoyed outings in the area in attempts to build relationships and friendships. We also enjoyed the annual Garden Route Christmas party, meeting fellow missionaries and lay workers involved in local churches in the cities of Knysna, Sedgefield and George.
