Good morning, Harvest Family!

I would like to share a short devotion and/or thought of the week with you each Sunday. Below is the first of many to come, as we look at

#### Christian Objectives

Proverbs 3:1-10 tells us, *My son forget not my law; But let thine heart keep my commandments: <sup>2</sup> For length of days, and long life, And peace, shall they add to thee. <sup>3</sup> Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: Bind them about thy neck; Write them upon the table of thine heart: <sup>4</sup> So shalt thou find favour and good understanding In the sight of God and man. <sup>5</sup> Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; And lean not unto thine own understanding. <sup>6</sup> In all thy ways acknowledge him, And he shall direct thy paths. <sup>7</sup> Be not wise in thine own eyes: Fear the LORD, and depart from evil. <sup>8</sup> It shall be health to thy navel, And marrow to thy bones. <sup>9</sup> Honour the LORD with thy substance, And with the firstfruits of all thine increase: <sup>10</sup> So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, And thy presses shall burst out with new wine.*

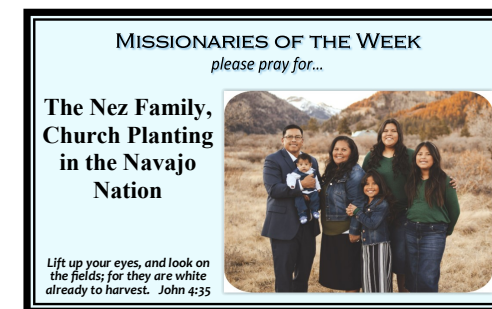
The First Objective is to **Develop a Close Personal Relationship with God.**

The Merriam Webster Dictionary describes relationship as *connecting or binding participants in a relationship: such as KINSHIP.*

Relationships are not built on do's and don'ts nor rules and regulations. They are built on the commonality of Kinship or a desire to bind together. In order to have this type of binding with God, we **must Strive to Obey His Word.** After all, He is our Heavenly Father, and we are His children. Notice two passages of scripture to help you in this Objective to Obey His Word.

Prov. 4:20-22 - *My son, attend to my words; Incline thine ear unto my sayings. <sup>21</sup> Let them not depart from thine eyes; Keep them in the midst of thine heart. <sup>22</sup> For they are life unto those that find them, And health to all their flesh.*

Eph. 5:1 - *Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children.*
