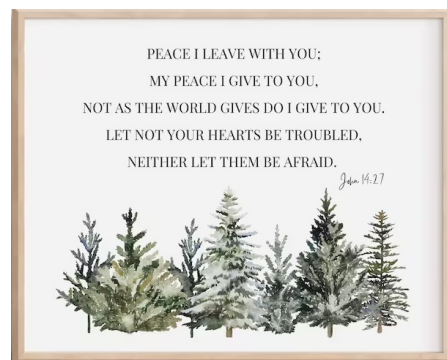
Rome had given the world peace from war. Jesus came to give man peace with God and peace within!

Wednesday Evening Service

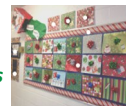
Service begins at 6:30 pm

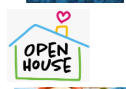

"For in Him we live, and move, and have our being."

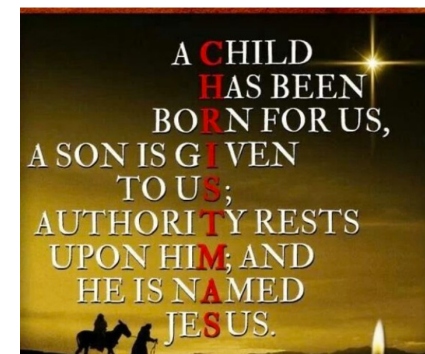
Incarnation means "the union of divinity with humanity in Jesus Christ."
