MINISTRY UPDATE

We have been excited with the opportunities the Lord has brought across our path this last month to build relationships and begin gospel-centered friendships.

- An Unexpected Friendship: Around Christmas, our family met a young mom, her daughter and her elderly mother at a local, community event while they were on holiday from Cape Town (a large city about 6 hours from us). A brief conversation at the event quickly led to an exchange of phone numbers and a promise to get our families together soon. The week after Christmas, we visited for 3 days in a row at our home, a quiet beach and local shops. Tori was able to share our faith and purpose here in Knysna while learning that the young Jewish mom was not at all connected to a faith in God. Tori continues to keep in touch and already has future get togethers planned.
- An Exciting Opportunity: This Friday, Frank is joining a monthly ministry of teaching Bible in one of Knysna's public schools. One Friday a month, he will be teaching biblical truths to a group of 5th and 6th graders. We are excited to see how the Lord uses this to build more relationships and further the gospel outreach to young people in our area.
- An Encouraging Grouping: Tori started a mom's chat group with some of the other moms of school-age children at church. This has led to get-togethers, discipleship opportunities and increased prayer for one another. This even encouraged one of the lady's husbands to desire a similar group for the men, so he began a men's chat group. Frank is building friendships and enjoying the iron-sharpening-iron opportunities they have together. We are so thrilled to see hearts seeking mutual encouragement around friendship and the truth of God's Word.
- An Upcoming Ministry: We are in the beginning stages of creating a youth ministry at our church, Lakeside Baptist. We hope to start in late March or early April with Friday youth meetings for children ages 10+. We hope to not only connect with the 8 young people from our church within this age range, but also others from the community as word spreads about this new ministry.
