Wherefore be ve not unwise, but understanding what the will the Lord is."

# To be prepared for the devil's attacks, take time to remember how he attacked you in the past.

While we all should strive for holiness, we still must fight temptation and the devil's attacks. Losing a battle here and there is no reason to give up or sideline ourselves from being used by God
