Reflect & Remember the Blessings of 2023

- Remember the Blessings.
- Remember the Mistakes.
- Remember Your Circumstances.
- Remember To Plan - Philippians 4:8-9

"Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you."

What do you want to accomplish this year spiritually?

Some have said that what doesn't get scheduled doesn't get done. **PLAN!**

Philippians gives a good outline of what should be our goal -things that are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, and of a good report.

Take a minute to think about your spiritual goals for 2024.

Some might be about Bible reading, prayer or spiritual growth. **Do you desire to be more for the Lord in 2024?**

V. Remember That God Helps - Philippians 4:10-13

"But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly, that now at the last your care of me hath flourished again; wherein ye were also careful, but ye lacked opportunity. Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content. I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me."

Rely on God's strength, and nothing will be too difficult. Another year is over, and a new one has begun. We've taken time to remember past blessings and mistakes, to reflect on our circumstances, and to make future plans.

How can we make 2024 better than 2023? How can we see spiritual growth and maturity? Paul gives us the key in Philippians 4:13, "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me."

As you consider spiritual and lifestyle changes, remember two things:

A. You cannot do good without God.

As much as you may determine to do good and desire to be a godly person, situations will arise, and your flesh will choose to do wrong. Realize that these times will come, and determine to resist your flesh and rely on God's help.

B. You can do anything with God.

No goal or accomplishment this coming year is too great for God to accomplish through you. Rely on God's strength, and nothing will be too difficult.

Find a piece of paper, or open a document on your computer. Make a list of spiritual goals you have for 2024. Be specific. Then pray over each item and ask God to give you strength to accomplish them this year. Your goal for 2024 should be to find yourself closer to God at the end of the year than at the beginning.
