Pastor's Corner

PULLING AWAY FROM GOD

1/28/24

Genesis 4:16: "Cain went out from the presence of the Lord, and dwelt in the land of Nod, on the east of Eden".

Cain, the first child of Adam and Eve, is the first of many that are not interested in God nor the people of God.

THE CAUSE

Cain's indifference in God was sin. It came because he murdered his brother, Abel.

In Genesis 4, Cain's sacrifice was without blood. The modernist and apostates of today preach a bloodless theology and persecute and criticize those who preach the necessity of the blood of Christ to cleanse from sin. Cain slayed his brother who did meet God's requirement. The anti-God attitude in our society is caused by sin. You cannot wink at abortion, homosexuality, drugs, and other sins and still desire to be in God's presence. If you are pulling away from church, Christian fellowship, your daily devotions etc. you might have a sin problem.

HIS BEHAVIOR

"Cain went out from the presence of the Lord." God is omnipresent and, in a sense, you can never get away from God. However, like Cain, you can intentionally move away from God. Cain did not want to be where God was. Your friends tell us a lot about your relationship with God.

Cain and Moses had a very different outlook toward God. Cain did not want God's presence, but Moses did not want to go anywhere without it (Exodus 33:15).

THE PLACE

"Dwelt in the land of Nod, on the east of Eden." Cain lived in the land of Nod. The word "Nod" means to wander. When you leave the presence of God, you will wander. Don't be lured into Nod by false promises of a better lifestyle or great riches. Nod is the land of false promises that lead to restless, false hope and ruin. "East of Eden" Eden was where God's honor was. Man was forbidden to enter Eden because he would not honor God's Word. Cain lived apart from Eden because he would not honor God's word.

Friend, do you dwell closer to Nod or Eden?
Your choices will expose you.
