The Gathering for the Passover(2)



Luke 22:21-30

- 21 But, behold, the hand of him that betrayeth me *is* with me on the table.
22 And truly the Son of man goeth, as it was determined: but woe unto that man by whom he is betrayed!
23 And they began to enquire among themselves, which of them it was that should do this thing.
24 And there was also a strife among them, which of them should be accounted the greatest.
25 And he said unto them, The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and they that exercise authority upon them are called benefactors. But ye *shall* not *be* so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.
27 For whether *is* greater, he that sitteth at meat, or he that serveth? *is* not he that sitteth at meat? but I am among you as he that serveth.
28 Ye are they which have continued with me in my temptations.
29 And I appoint unto you a kingdom, as my Father hath appointed unto me; That ye may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

The Passover was a yearly observance to celebrate the Israelites' escape from Egypt. All four Gospels record a lengthy passage about the Passover observance which Christ and the disciples had in the upper room just prior to the crucifixion.

Pastor's Corner 2/4/2024

THE DISOBEDIENCE OF LOT'S WIFE

Genesis 19:26

"But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt"

As Sodom was being destroyed by Divine judgment, Lot's wife disobeyed the Lord and looked back. Her disobedience brought judgment.

THE REPETITION OF HER DISOBEDIENCE

"But his wife looked back." Looking back revealed problems in Lot's wife. We have similar problems in our church today. Are we looking back toward the sin of the old life?

"Looked back." The eye gate, if not protected, it will lead to sin. Hollywood productions have diminished much Christian zeal and ruined the lives of many Christians. Be careful what you look at; it can lead to corruption and ruin your life.

"Looked back." The wrong desires will lead to wrong thinking. Lot's wife longed for the things of wicked Sodom. Colossians 3:2 tells us to "Set your affections on things above not on things of this world".

THE RESIDENCE OF HER DISOBEDIENCE

"From behind him." Lot's wife was in the wrong place. She did not have a heart for the things of God. The angels had to grab their hands and bring them out of Sodom (Genesis 19:16), but she looked back. The wicked city had seared their conscience to the things of God. "From behind him." Some locations make it easier to sin than other locations. If we are residing in a location where we are not seen, we will not be confronted with our sin or temptation to sin. Being behind meant that no one would see her. We should thank God for any circumstance that hinders our sinning.

THE RESULT OF HER DISOBEDIENCE

"She became a pillar of salt." Her disobedience resulted in judgment. Rebellious Christians will face the judgment of God. "She became a pillar of salt." That pillar gave no honor to Lot's wife; it shamed her. Sin will not honor the sinner. It says it will, but it only leads to shame and dishonor.

"She became a pillar of salt." Salt has value and is of great use, but not as a pillar of judgment. Lot's wife became worthless. She was no longer of any use in God's service. Friend, sin will make you dysfunctional in God's service. Many folks have rendered themselves useless to the Lord through their sinful actions and choices.
