#### Pastor's Corner **IMMORALITY**

"The sons of Jacob came out of the field when they heard it; and the men were grieved, and they were very wroth, because he had wrought folly in Israel in lying with Jacob's daughter; which thing ought not to be done" - Genesis 34:7

The older sons of Jacob did not have a good reputation. They demonstrated their bad behavior when they sold their brother, Joseph, into slavery. However, they did respond well about the shameful immorality of their only sister, Dinah.

#### THEIR KNOWLEDGE OF THE IMMORALITY

"They heard it." The first thing we learn in our text about immorality is that it was known. Immoral conduct is done in secret, but it is not kept secret. Sooner or later, it comes out, and the guilty parties are exposed for their sinful actions. An unexpected pregnancy due to immorality is a real exposure. but even if pregnancy is not involved, the sin may still be known publicly. "Be sure your sin will find vou out" (Numbers 32:23).

#### THEIR REACTION TO THE IMMORALITY

"The men were grieved, and they were very wroth." Jacob's sons were upset to say the least. If we are not upset about immorality, we are a corrupt people. Corruption describes our land which does not seem to be grieved about adultery, fornication, or homosexuality. Our attitude about sin says much about our character. If we tolerate evil (which our society certainly does), evil will become acceptable, and ruin and destruction will follow. The acceptance of this horrible immorality is evidenced by laws which protect the immoral lifestyle of homosexuals and brothels.

#### THEIR EVALUATION OF THE IMMORALITY

"He had wrought folly in Israel in lying with Jacob's daughter, which thing ought not to be done." Their evaluation was wrong. There is a gross inconsistency in our evaluation when we condemn only one party in the act of immorality. Dinah was not innocent. However, it does take two to tango. Immorality is foolish conduct. Amnon, David's son, was told that if he committed immorality, "Thou shalt be as one of the fools in Israel" (1 Samuel 13:13). The immoral play the fool, even if they are popular, musicians, athletes, models or Hollywood

"Which thing ought not to be done." Immorality is sinful behavior. It is very clear in the Word of God that it is forbidden. Joseph recognized this truth (Genesis 39), when he fled from Potiphar's wife. as she made advances day by day. But many think they are smarter than God and continue to live a life of immorality.
