Vote Biblically This Election Season!

One of the most fundamental things we can do as Christians is to steward wisely the means and responsibilities God has given us. One of those responsibilities is voting for the right candidate — a candidate with Biblical values. Allow me to share with you three things that will assist you in voting Biblically.

1. Pray for our local elected officials and the leaders of our country. As you know, we have this listed on our Wednesday night prayer sheet that is updated each week. There is much power in prayer! God hears our prayers, and He is able to move moun-

2. Do your research about the candidates running for election. The best way to know which candidate has true Biblical values is to do your own research. It's important to know who we are voting for! Nominees will be finalized at the respective party's National Convention in July and August. Next, the general election will take place on November 5th.
