BACK TO BETHEL

"God said unto Jacob, Arise, go up to Bethel, and dwell there; and make there an altar unto God, that appeared unto thee when thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy brother" - Genesis 35:1

Jacob had settled in an evil place (Genesis 33:18). A place where his family discovered that sin begets sin. Jacob and his family needed revival.

THE INSTRUCTION FOR REVIVAL "Arise go up to Bethel and dwell there". The first step for revival is obedience to the Word of God. Revival will come when we are obedient to the Scriptures. Many have strayed far from the Word of God today in favor of worldly philosophies and fear of not being politically correct. We need revival! Being obedient and Biblically correct is the first step.

THE PLACE OF REVIVAL "Arise, go up to Bethel." Obedience will put us in the right place for revival. We have been dwelling in the wrong places and with the wrong people. This action is harmful to the holiness of our behavior and the health of our souls.

In Bethel Jacob dedicated himself to the Lord but had strayed and needed to return to that place in his life. Similarly, the church at Ephesus was told to "do the first works" (Revelation 2:5). God told Jacob to "go up to Bethel". This symbolically tells us that revival will put us on higher ground because sin only brings us down.

THE RESULTS OF REVIVAL "Bethel." Revival will put us in better place. Jacob had been living in an unholy place, and his choices resulted in sinful behavior. "Bethel" means house of God. Friend, revival will take you out of the place of sin and put you back to Bethel.

God said, "Make there an altar unto God". Revival will improve our worship habits. Altars require sacrifices. Revival will loosen the strings of our purse at offering time and stir us to service.

THE BLESSING OF REVIVAL "God, that appeared unto thee." This was a reminder of the dream God had given Jacob during his first visit to Bethel. Spiritual blessings come with revival.

"When thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy brother." Jacob was hiding from his brother, Esau, at that time. He ran instead of trusting God. God still protected him from Esau, but revival would protect him again.

Friend, if we want revival, we must seek God's help in getting back to our Bethel. His Instructions will lead us to the Place where the Results of Revival will bless us and our family.
