Pastor's Corner

FRUITFULNESS

3/10/2024

"Joseph is a fruitful bough, even a fruitful bough by a well: whose branches run over the wall" (Genesis 49:22)

Genesis 49 records Joseph's father, Jacob, giving his last words to his twelve sons. Some of his words were negative due to the unholy lives they lived, but what he said of Joseph was positive due to his holy and faithful life. Joseph lived a fruitful life that spared many, due to his character and performance as a good steward.

THE EVIDENCE OF FRUITFULNESS - "Joseph is a fruitful bough."

"Bough" means branch. Joseph was certainly a fruitful branch and was known for his character and preparation to provide food during a great famine. If you are a Christian, fruit will be your evidence. Many claim to be a Christian but do not produce fruit to support their claim. Jesus said, "Ye shall know them by their fruits", in Matthew 7:16. Joseph's life produced fruit everywhere he lived.

Whether he was at home, being persecuted, serving in Potiphar's house, cast into a prison or serving in the palace, Joseph continued to produce the fruit of love, patience, obedience, long suffering and faith in God. Where or what is your evidence of being a fruitful Christian?

THE SOURCE FOR FRUITFULNESS - "By a well."

As we have seen here in Arizona, plants and even cacti, will wither and die without water. Jacob described Joseph as being planted and growing "by a well". This meant that Joseph had consistent spiritual nutrition to provide fruit in his life.

The well is a symbol of the relationship he had with God. Joseph lived near the Lord all his life. If you want to be fruitful as a Christian, you must get into the Word and allow God to produce fruit through you. Those who do not let the Word of God dwell in them richly will not produce much fruit for the Lord. Colossians 3:16 says, Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord."

THE REACH OF FRUITFULNESS - "Over the wall.

Joseph's branches are described as reaching "over the wall". His branches reached beyond the area around the tree and well. His fruitfulness blessed the lives around him, as well as many that were beyond his physical reach. Joseph's fruitfulness blessed the lives of the known world with his great work before and during the great famine.

Does our fruit reach "over the wall" locally and globally? A Christian demonstrates fruitfulness when they reach "over the wall" in their dedication to help spread the Gospel to the world that is both local and global.

What a joy to pastor a church that desires to have a great reach both locally globally! May the Lord bless our Missions Program as we attempt to reach "over the wall" and produce much fruit.
