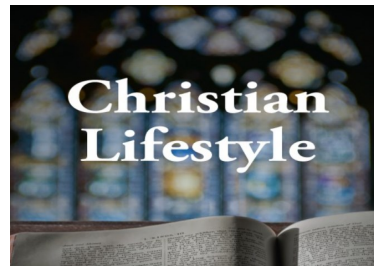

THE RIGHT LIFESTYLE

"Rise up early in the morning and stand before Pharaoh; lo, he cometh forth to the water, and say unto him, Thus said the LORD, Let my people go, that they may serve me" Exodus 8:20

The instructions given to Moses by God provide the right kind of principles. These principles are greatly needed in our generation.

RIGHT CONTROL - *"Rise up early in the morning."* Folks who accomplish much in a 24-hour period have self-control and are well-organized, disciplined and not lazy. Moses did not get things done by lounging in his tent until mid-morning. Discipline does not lounge when tasks need to be accomplished. Moses got up early and got busy.

RIGHT RESPONSIBILITY - *"Stand before Pharaoh."* I am sure that standing before Pharaoh was intimidating for Moses. Responsibility is not always easy, but necessary. Responsibility often involves difficult circumstances and challenges. Doing the easy might be the quick way out, but it doesn't accomplish the task at hand, nor does it benefit those who count on your example or leadership.

RIGHT PERSISTENCE - *"Lo, he cometh forth to the water"*

The Lord tells Moses where Pharaoh will be. The persistence of Moses responded to the opportunity. Some folks complain that they are not getting any breaks and that life never favors them. The problem with complainers is a lack of persistence. Moses did not delay or procrastinate. He carried out his responsibility as directed by the Lord. If you want to get your task done, get up and get moving.

RIGHT MESSAGE - *"Thus said the LORD."* Pharaoh needed to hear, *"Thus said the LORD."* Our world needs to hear that message as well. We have allowed social media and the woke movement redefine freedom, morals, privilege, and genders. What the world needs to hear is what the Lord has to say. Share the Right Message.

RIGHT DEDICATION - *"Let my people go that they may serve me."*

Why did the Children of Israel need freedom? The freedom the Lord wants for His children allows you to serve Him better. Israel's deliverance from Egypt was to allow them to serve God freely. Does the world control your lifestyle? Are you dedicated to a lifestyle of serving God?
