MINISTRY UPDATE

Celebrating Easter provides so many new open doors to share the hope we have because we serve a risen Savior! Many are more open to talking about spiritual things this time of year.

Frank is giving a weekly devotional on Psalms to a small class in our Knysna Hope Launch class, a computer-training class our ministry team offers to those in the community. Right now, there is just one married couple attending this particular class, but they both need Christ as Savior. Time spent sharing the gospel is never wasted time! This past week, Frank also had the opportunity to preach last-minute for a local pastor who was suddenly sick at his church on Sunday and then again at a local nursing home. Hudson enjoyed going with him and bringing some cheer to the grannies at the home.

Monday through Friday, Tori continues to work with three grade 7 students for an hour-long reading/spelling lesson at our children's school. She has had wonderful gospel conversations with the students, starting with how sin entered the world through Adam & Eve. One of the students, who we will call "T", is especially attentive and has expressed a desire to follow Christ. Please pray for wisdom for Tori as she attempts to clear away the confusion of this young girls' pagan beliefs to shed light on the truths of the gospel. She will also be starting work this week in a second school with a grade 2 boy who struggles with reading due to his dyslexia, autism and ADHD.

We have two young boys from the kids' school coming over to play with our kids and then attend a Bible Kids Club every Friday afternoon. Please pray as we continue to pour into not only these young boys' lives (grades 2 & 5), but also their families.

As we are settling in more and more into Knysna, we have also worked to developed deeper relationships with our neighbors and community. This past month saw dinners in our home with three different families (two different neighbors and our realtor and her boyfriend) as well as multiple get-togethers with families from our church. Every meet-up gives additional opportunity for Christ-centered conversation.
