## The Wonder of it All Luke 24:1-12



In our passage today, we find the women coming to the tomb of Jesus early Sunday morning. When they arrived, they found the stone rolled away and an empty tomb. What a Wonder!

- Wonder (n) – 1. a cause of astonishment or admiration : **MARVEL**  
2. amazed admiration  
3. a feeling of doubt or uncertainty.

**SAVED BY THE BLOOD** "The blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are; and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you" (Exodus 12:13). The last plague was coming, and instructions are given to escape the judgment through the protection of blood. They were to slay a lamb (type of Christ) and put the blood on the door posts (type of the cross).

**ITS IMPORTANCE** - "The blood." From Genesis to Revelation, the blood is emphasized for salvation. Hebrews 9:22 states, "that without the shedding of blood there is no remission of sins". Revelation 12:11 says, "And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb". And 1 John 1:7 states, "the blood of Jesus Christ cleanses from all sin". Notice the consistent emphasis on the blood for salvation? A hymnbook without the blood is not biblical and denies the importance of the blood of Christ. Have you been saved by the Blood? Can you sing the chorus of "Saved by the Blood"?

*Glory, I'm saved! glory, I'm saved! My sins are all pardoned, my guilt is all gone! Glory, I'm saved! Glory, I'm saved! I'm saved by the blood of the Crucified One!*

The importance of the blood is presented as the only way of escape in the last plague and throughout the Word of God.

**ITS SHELTER** - "When I see the blood, I will pass over you." The blood would shelter from judgment. God was only looking for the blood applied to the door posts. It did not matter who lived there. It was all about the blood. Today, it is still about the blood. Salvation comes when your sins have been washed away by the blood of Christ. "Ye were not redeemed with corruptible things as silver and gold ... but with the precious blood of Christ" (1 Peter 1:18, 19).

**ITS LOCATION** - "The blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are." The blood must be on the house to be protected. Being in a relative's house would not save you. Unless you personally put your faith in Jesus Christ for salvation, you will not be saved.

**ITS AUTHORITY** - "When I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you." No authority or judgment has power over the blood of the Lamb. Egypt had a mighty army, but they were no match for God. Only the blood has the power to stop Divine judgment. The blood of Christ still does that today.
