Pastor's Corner

4/14/2024 LAWS

LAWS OF BLESSING

Exodus 23:7

Keep thee far from a false matter; and the innocent and righteous slay thou not; for I will not justify the wicked.

Many laws which God gave the Israelites do not apply to us today. However, some laws and commandments are applicable to any society. They show basic and important principles of life which we need to follow. This text is an example of that.

THE LAW OF SEPARATION - "Keep thee far from a false matter." Separation from evil is a good principle for any people. Why should we separate from evil? Evil is corrupting. 1 Corinthians 15:33 - Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners. If you do not stay away from evil, it will corrupt you. It is also contagious. Like the flu or a cold, evil spreads and affects many people. Proverbs 1:10 - My son, if sinners entice thee, Consent thou not. Stay away from it! Separation is not popular today. The world would have you think that you need to compromise in every area of your life to fit in with society. The loudest voice wins the argument and not facts nor Biblical truths. This is especially demonstrated in the ecumenical attitude that mixes false doctrine with some true doctrine. I have never and have no plans to be a part of the liberal, compromising local ministerial association. They have been corrupting young ministers for years and now they have joined the woke movement. If you do not want the wrath of society and the woke movement, do not be a separatist. Me, I have decided to "Follow Jesus" and not some new loud, compromising movement.

THE LAW OF SLAYING - The innocent and righteous slay thou not. Today, this principle needs to be applied to the cruelty of abortion. No one is more innocent than the unborn child. A wounded animal or a protected species gets more sympathy than an unborn child. When you ignore God's commands your reasoning becomes folly. Abortion still violates God's command and will bring judgment upon those involved.

THE LAW OF SANCTITY - "I will not justify the wicked." Don't join the world by giving in and justifying the wicked. Sin is still sin at any level. Whether it is abortion, homosexuality, alcohol, drugs, or any other wicked deed. If our government approves of it, you better look at your Bible for verification. For example, you can speak slander toward God and Christianity easier than you can speak against Political correctness and the woke movement. However, God said that He will not justify the wicked. He will duly punish sin.
