Greetings from the field,

We thank the Lord for His grace throughout the last month. Although it might seem sometimes, that not much is happening, as I reflect on the last month, God has blessed here. As reported in past letters, we have begun work on the new added space. God has provided the funds to make most of the improvements we had planned, and we are getting the work done as best we can with all the discipleship and other ministry obligations we have. It's a great problem to have, being so busy. God even sent us some help from Louisiana to help with the painting. What a blessing!

We have the new space set up now for Teen Church. There is a young man in the work here that God has called to preach, so I have given him the opportunity to preach to the teens in Dutch. We are hoping that this ministry will be fruitful and grow. Eventually, as the Lord leads, I will allow some of the other men to also rotate in this class to help them grow in ministry. Last Saturday was King's Day here and we went to the streets as normal to evangelize. We were expecting a great deal of opposition, but it turned out to be a very prosperous day. Proverbs 16:7, "When a man's ways please the LORD, he maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him." I guess I should just worry about keeping this principal, and let God work out the rest. Many people heard the gospel, and we gave out more tracts than I can remember in a single day. We eagerly pray and wait to see what kind of fruit the Lord will give us from going faithfully to the streets of Amsterdam. We had the baptism for Alex last month after he was saved in March. Lisa has started a beginner's discipleship with him on Wednesday evenings during our weekly Bible study.

As for prayer requests. Over the last 6 months, we have had a small group of young people begin to come to Sunday services. They say they are looking to learn the Bible. Pray that God give us the wisdom to help them in this and that they will begin discipleship with Lisa and me. We are having a young lady visit the field on a mission trip in a couple weeks, pray we can be a blessing to her. Pray for us to be able to finish more of the projects in the new space. Pray for us to have wisdom in decisions being made for the future. We thank the Lord for all your faithful prayers and support for the work here. We know that without your prayers, not near as much would be accomplished for God's glory. Know also that we are praying for you!
