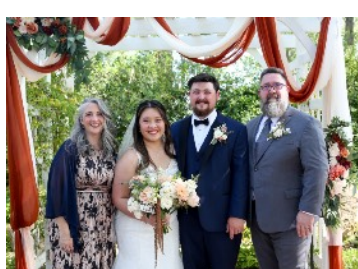




Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it. 1Thessalonians 5:24
