discipling him too. Please pray for his spiritual growth and also for the salvation of his family.

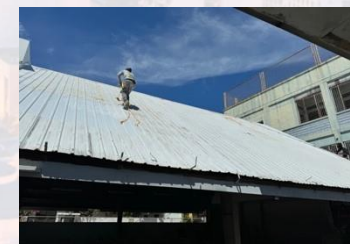
