It will be our desire to get all new people into the discipleship program as soon as they are willing. We are really getting a lot of work done as far as tracting Hilverum. We are hoping to have the whole city tracted by the end of the year. We have another young lady from Michigan visiting us for a couple weeks and we are planning to get her involved with this a bit while she is here. Street preaching has been going well. We were able to tract a week of the pride event in Amsterdam 2 weeks ago without problems. Many tracts were given and we are praying for these to bear fruit for God's glory.

A couple of our people we really stirred by the preaching at the Bible conference, would you pray that they don't lose the desire to serve better. Please pray for us to have wisdom in the discipleship ministry. We don't want to stretch ourselves too thin and not be effective in this ministry.
