MEDICAL MINISTRIES

As of July 31, 2024, I am a Registered Nurse in South Africa. Now I am in the process of moving forward to start a wound care clinic in the Walmer Location. I know the need is all over the city. In the last week, I have gone several days to dress the wounds of a man whose fingers were wounded by a knife. When I first saw his fingers there was concern as to whether he would be able to regain full use of them or not, one was infected. He had been to the government hospital, but all they did was wrap them and send him home. God is good and his fingers are healing. I know there are more out there just like this man who need help. Please pray with me as I start the process to open the clinic. I will be sending out a video update in the future about the location and my needs as I prepare to start up, *so be on the lookout*. Please pray for me as I seek the Lord's direction in every aspect of this clinic and that many people will be reached with the Gospel.

VISA SITUATION

I have the ability now to apply for a critical skills visa and I am working with an immigration lawyer to do this, but my time is limited. Please pray that all will be sorted within the time frame required.
