This picture is still one of my favorite photos. What are the odds of both workers picking up two different logs to form a CROSS? The rough-cut lumber went to build a place of worship.

From inside a building in far off places the Word of God is arriving via solar radios with Biblical programs in their own language.



This picture might look a bit posed, but their



surroundings are very real. The Word of God is arriving in their homes; they are listening to it and are very glad to have a solar powered radio to listen to the programs.

Another way the stories of the Bible are arriving in their homes is via cellphones, microchips

loaded with videos such as the Jesus Film voiced over in their language. Here is a magnifying screen, behind it is a cellphone playing the Jesus Film. There is even a chicken in attendance.





For this trip we had purchased 60 radios in advance and had them in storage. We purchased 1,000 microchips to load up for these radios. We met a new couple that works in a very remote area. What a joy it was to meet them and hear their need for audio and visual materials. We are busy getting radios ready to send to this new area. It takes them 30 hours by boat to reach various villages tucked away in the jungle river systems. This trip ten solar radios will be traveling a long way. Please pray for a safe

delivery!

This picture came from another missionary. What do you see in this photo? How many cellphones do you see? What mode of transportation? See the barrels of fuel in the back of the boat? With that much fuel they are on a long trip to visit these isolated people. We need to get microchips to them and solar radios with the message of HOPE.



There are several locations which can be reached by airplane. The runways didn't get there by chance. Many hands were needed to cut out a landing strip with months of hard work. The grass is cut by hand and a few grass-eating animals help keep it down. When the plane comes in many come out to see what has arrived. In this case several solar radios arrived; they were laid out on the plane's wing.



We are all very privileged to serve these people and we thank each of you for your prayers and financial help.
